Malcolm presented on the review of the Community Empowerment (Scotland) Act 2015, covering the methodology of the review, the key findings and the next steps following publication of the reports on the act, Part 3 and Part 5. Malcolm invited SLC to join the National Asset Transfer Group.

A discussion followed which covered the following:

- The review and report were welcomes by members
- The timescale for next steps and whether legislative change might follow
- The need for changes to the Scottish Public Finance Manual to enable decisionmaking that supports transfers to communities
- Issues around pricing of assets and book value versus market value
- Issue of terms and conditions of sale after approval of transfers, especially when done at a late stage and what could be done to help address this.
